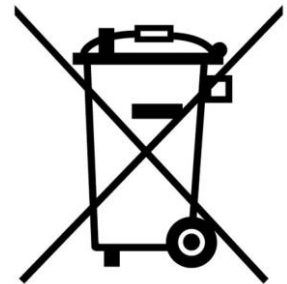


Disposal of waste electrical and electronic equipment

Disposal of electrical and electronic equipment

The crossed-out bin indicates that it is mandatory by law to dispose of equipment marked with this symbol separately from unsorted municipal waste. Disposal via domestic waste is expressly prohibited. If the devices do not contain permanently installed batteries or rechargeable batteries, these must be removed and disposed of separately before disposal.



Options for returning old appliances

Owners of old electrical appliances can return them via the collection systems set up and made available by the public waste disposal authorities for the return and collection of old appliances. This ensures proper disposal of the old equipment. You can view a list of collection and return points online at the following link:

Disposal of lamps and light sources

According to the ElektroG, technical luminaires from administration, industry, commerce and trade, as well as all non-residential luminaires purchased before March 2006, must be disposed of by the user. Technical luminaires purchased after this date are marked with the symbol of a crossed-out trash can shown above. You can also dispose of these luminaires via the above-mentioned collection and return points of the public waste disposal authorities. You can find an option in your area as described under the above link.

Incandescent lamps and LEDs are not subject to the regulations of the ElektroG. Nevertheless, we recommend that you dispose of them separately. Mobile hazardous waste collection points, local recycling centers or retail take-back points are available for this purpose and ensure safe disposal and recovery of raw materials.
